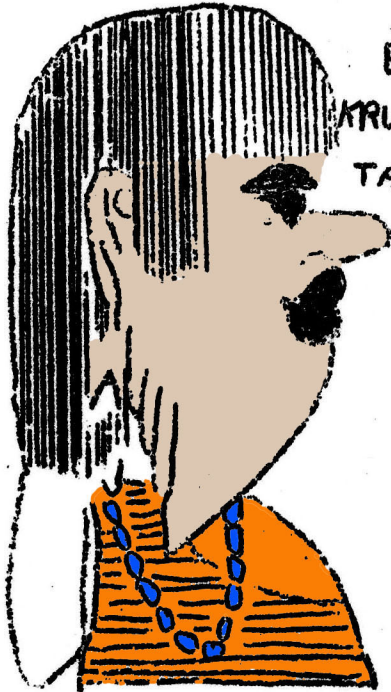

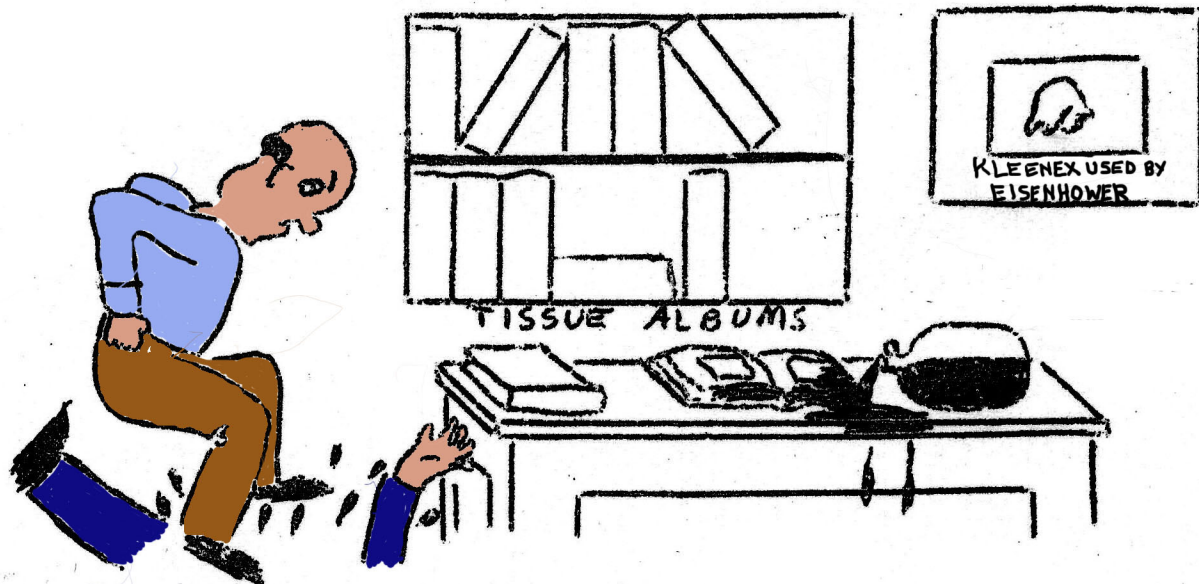
BOWLING

IS RUINING OUR ADULTS

All the talk about juvenile delinquents is propaganda spread by adults to turn attention from their own crimes. Although adults make up a relatively unimportant part of the American population, we don't want them all to be delinquents. On the following pages, BURP demonstrates the fact that a major cause of adult delinquency is the corrupt game of bowling. An employer admonishes his butler for spilling sirup on his valuable rare tissue collection. The butler moaned that he had always "wanted to spill the maple."

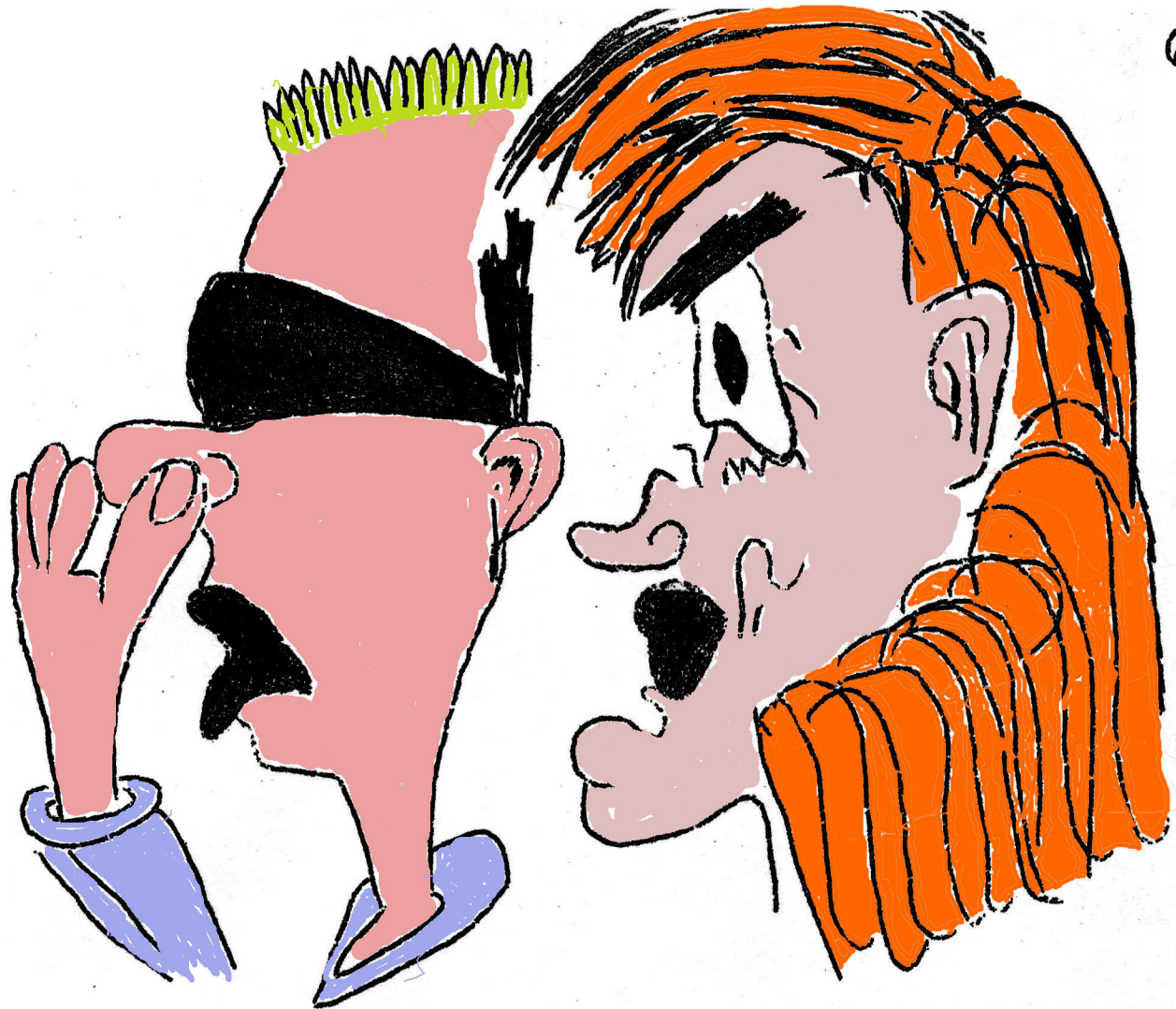
A notorious teamster (right) organizes a strike of coffee-tasters in Ohmypa, Pa. He told reporters he "won't settle for anything less than a strike."



After this undeniable proof that bowling causes adult delinquency, BURP explains one reason why.

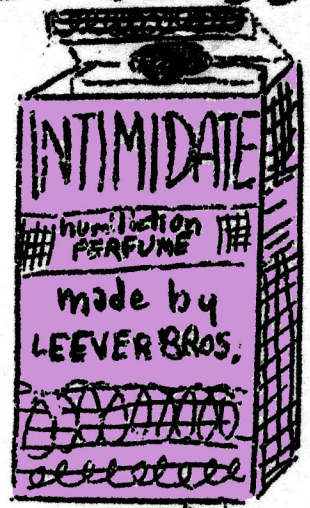

This sample of the complicated bowling scoring system shows plainly one of the chief causes of mental unbalance and criminal tendencies in today's adults. An "X" in the little square at the upper right of each big rectangle means either 11 pins knocked down or squashed with one ball, or 10 pins knocked down or squashed without any balls (rare). A diagonal line means the ball went over the pins on first bounce, unless a pin boy was critically injured. However, if the pin boy dies after five transfusions, it counts as a half spare. When over 3/4's of a spare counts, take the square root of the number of the frame you are in and multiply it by the reciprocal of your telephone number to get the size of your bowling shoes.

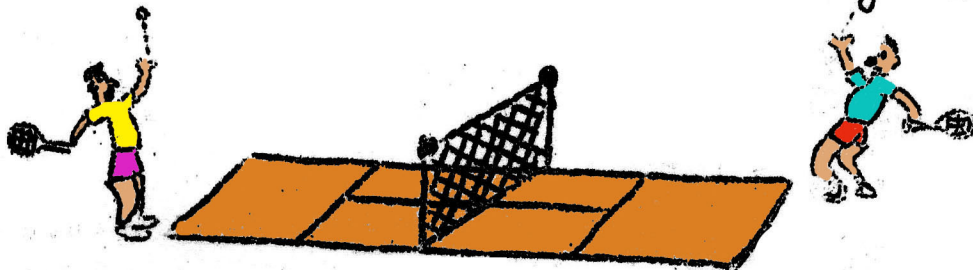

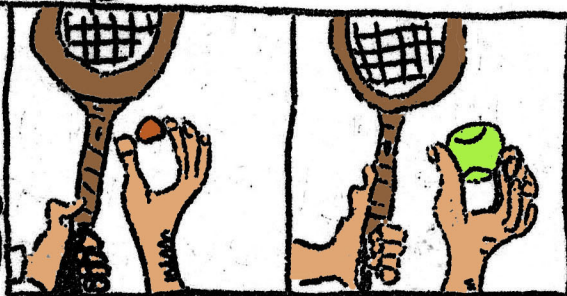

1. The Grip

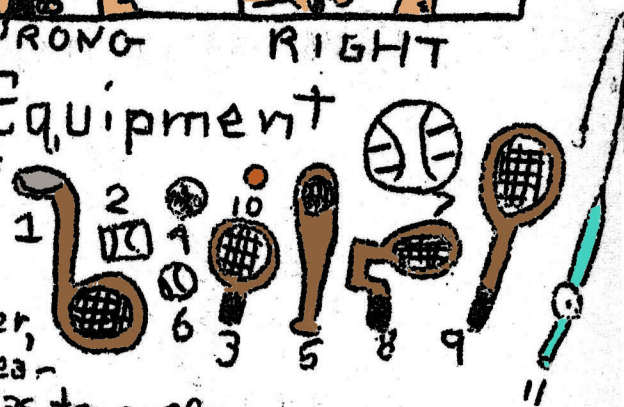

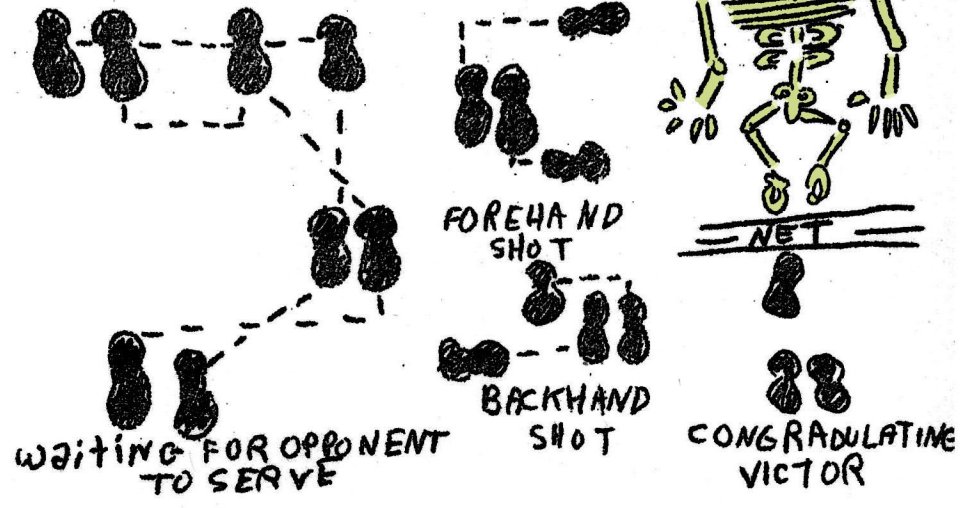
2. The Equipment

Many money-grabbing sporting-goods stores will attempt to sell you the incorrect equipment for your sport, or factory rejects (such as #2 and #8), but BURP is here to save the day. For the extreme beginner, may we suggest #7 and #3. After a year of play, try #6 and #9. When undecided as to preference of tennis or golf, try #1 with #6. If you want a harder ball, try #4. Finally, after having conquered the strokes, we recommend #10 and #5 to keep you from being bored. If you do become bored, give it up and try #11.

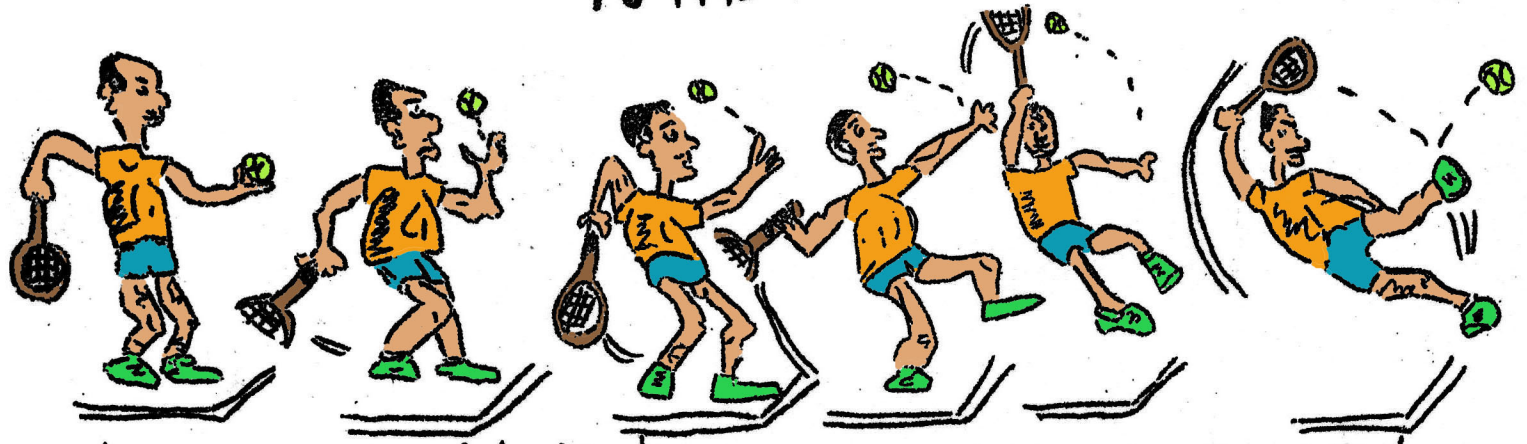

4. THE SERVE

5. THE VOLLEY

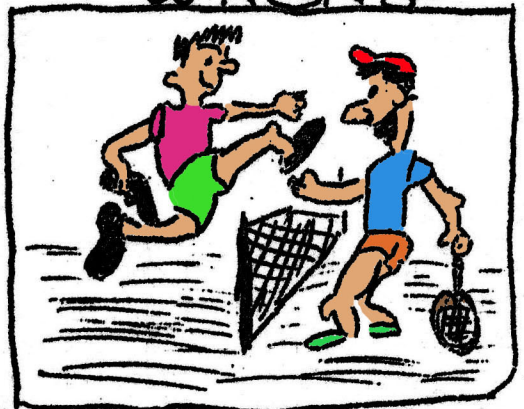
we can't explain how Harry's name got in the winner's box on score card #2, or how that blood stain got there, either.

7. SPORTSMANSHIP

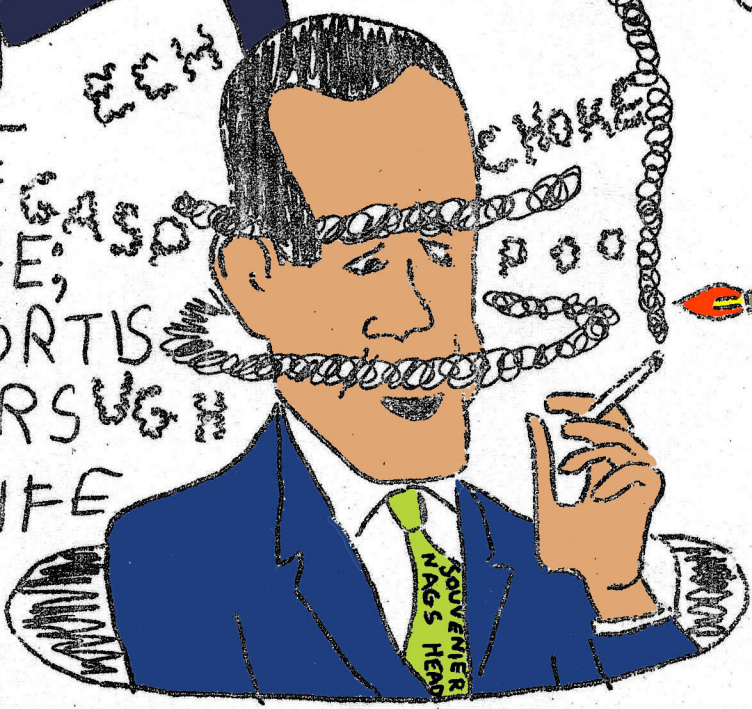

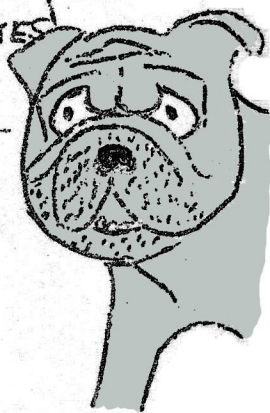

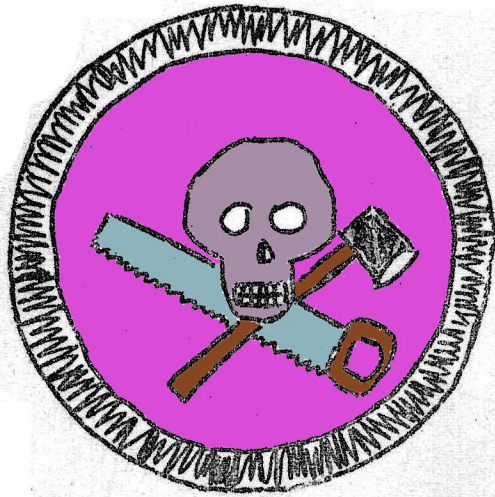

(b) If counselor has wife and more than two kids, or has no life insurance, perform operation described in 3(a) on yourself.



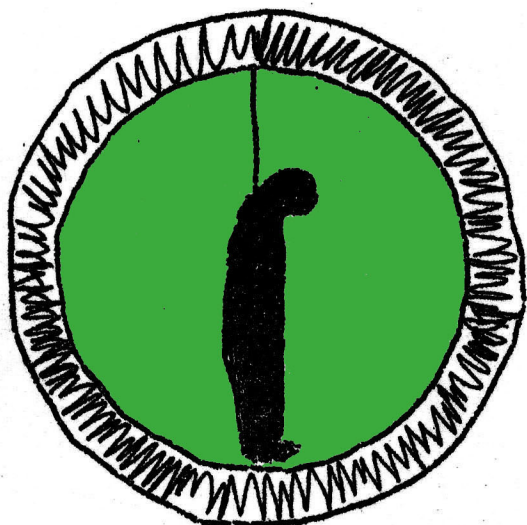
MERIT BADGE

MERIT BADGE

1. Demonstrate proficiency in embroidering teensy details such as houses, people, scout equipment, and common street gang weapons.

2. Exhibit ability to black mail, coax, cajole, bribe, threaten, or otherwise persuade merit badge counsellor.

3. Possess at least 95 merit badges, no more than 20 of which must be stolen, no more than 50 home-made, and no more than three earned. The rest may be obtained in any other scout-like manner.

2. After completing requirement number 1, do one of the following successfully: commit suicide by stabbing self in back, or comply with part 3 (b) of Surgery merit badge.

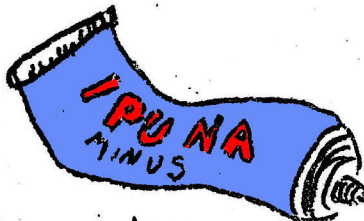
